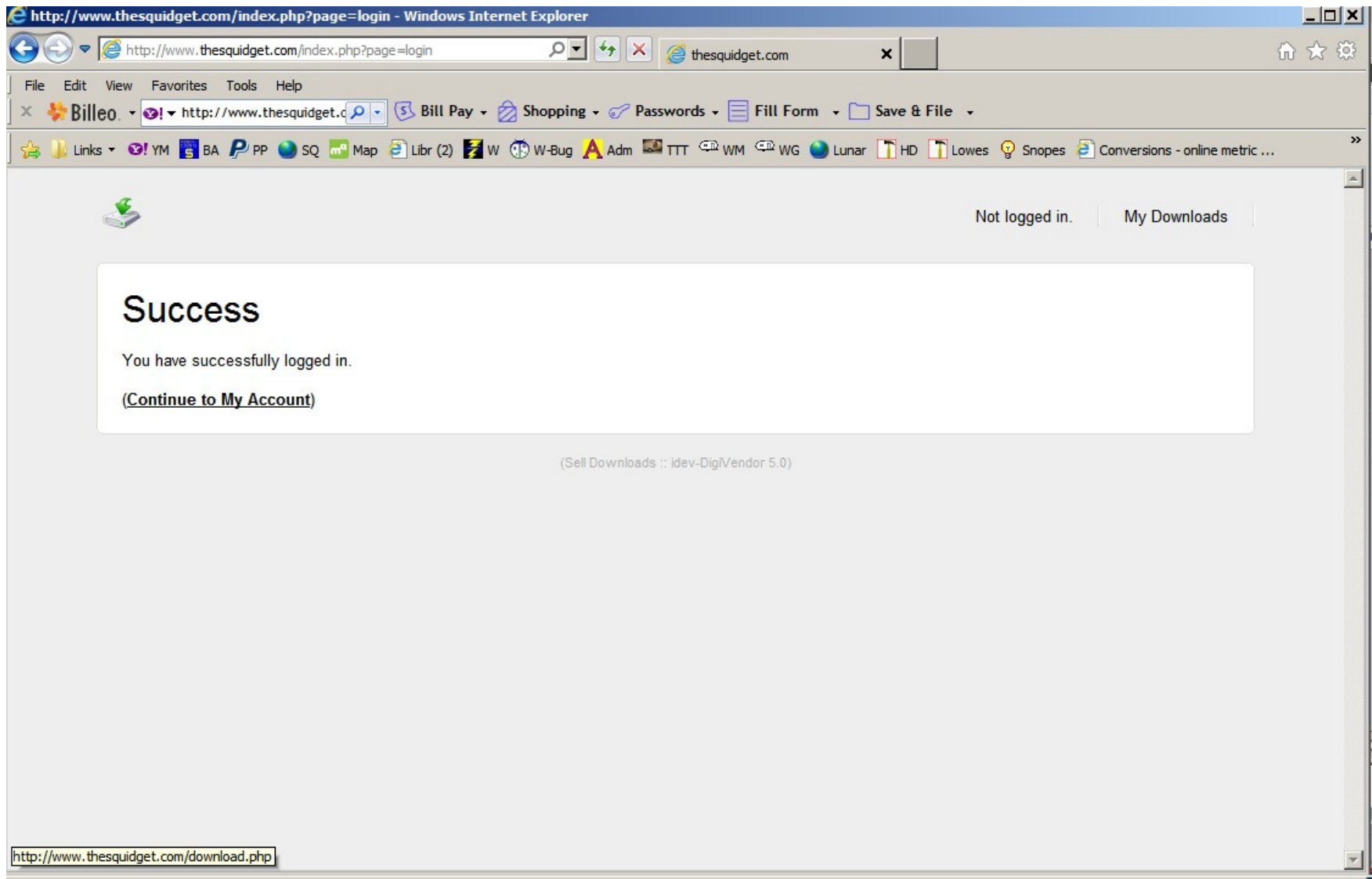

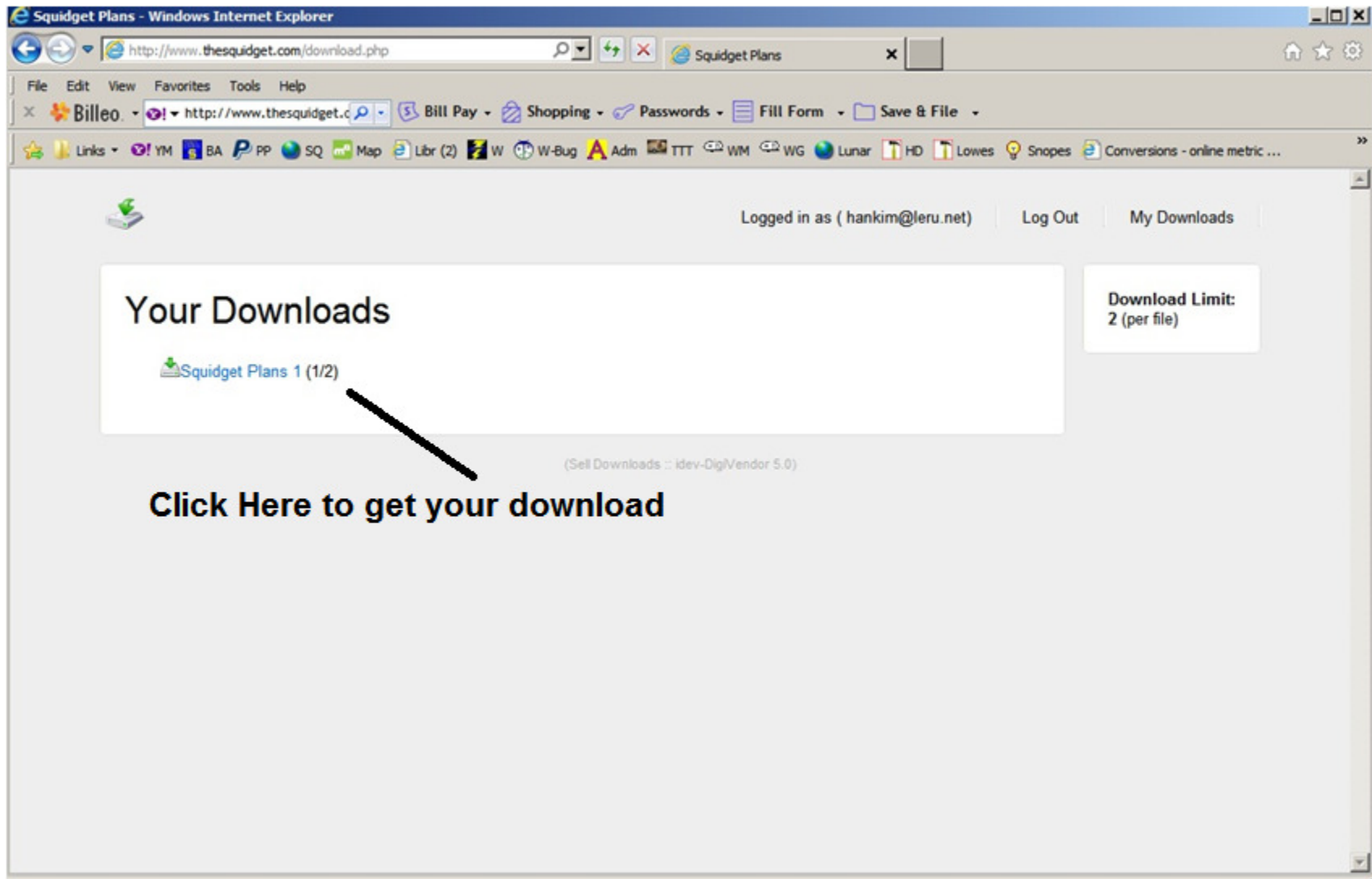

Click on the Sign In button

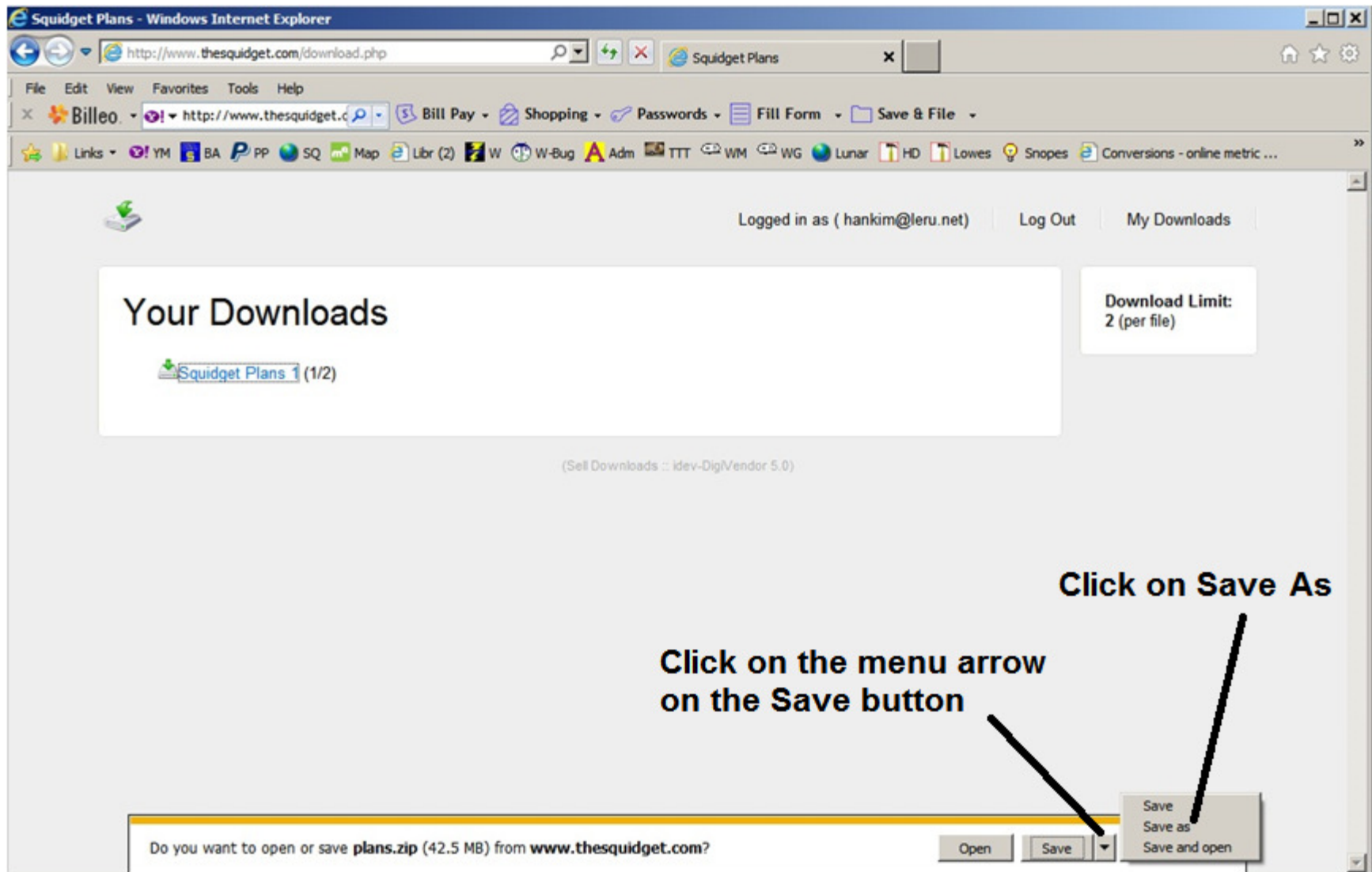
1. Paste the provided download URL in your browser window to go to this download page.
2. Enter your email address and provided password and click on Sign In button.



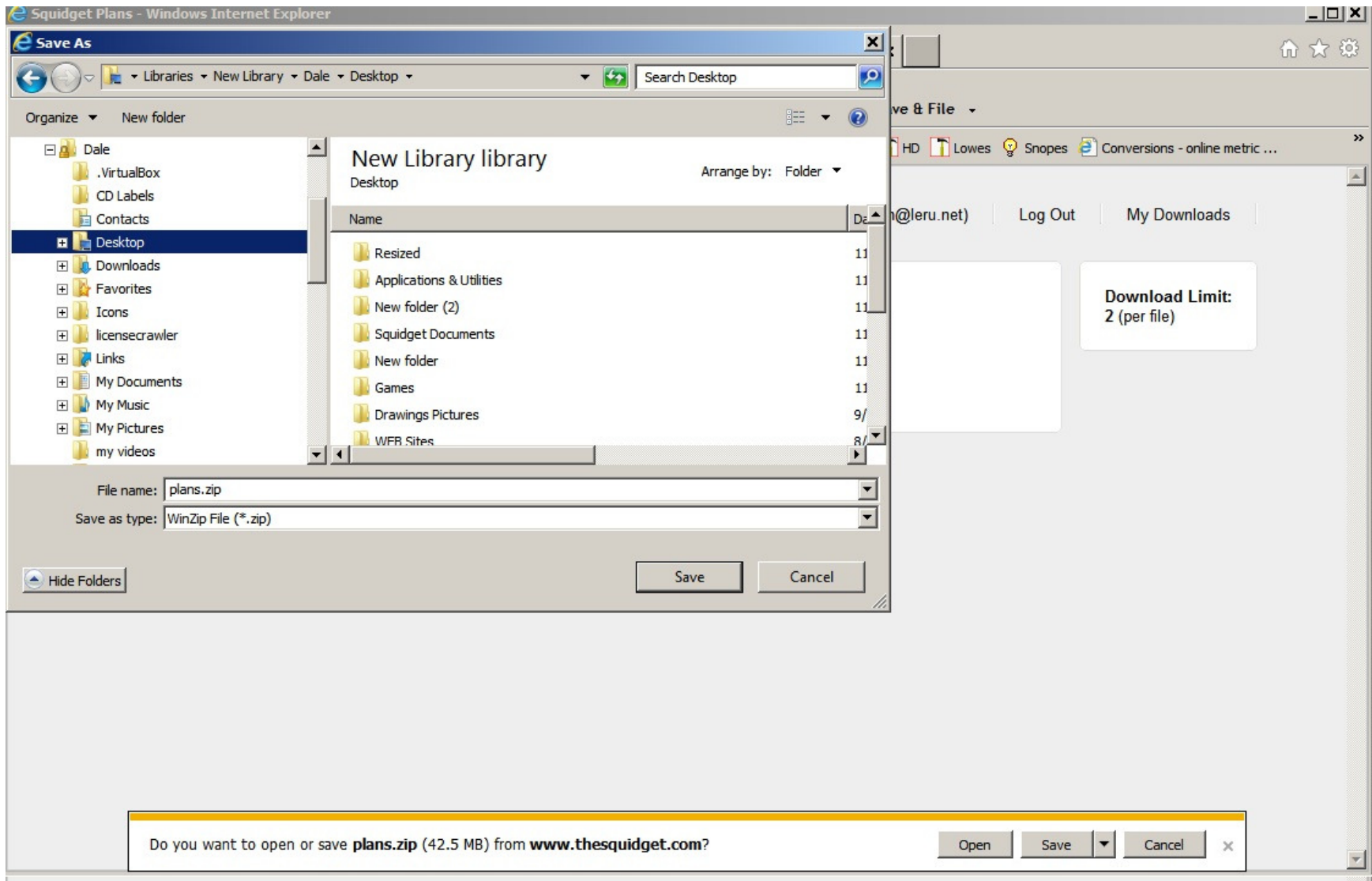
Once logged in, click on the Continue to My Account button



When you see the Squidget Plans or Pop Top Plans, click on it.



After clicking on the plans button, the download box should pop up at the bottom of your screen. Click on the Save menu arrow (Not on Save). Select the Save As option and click on it.



Select a folder in which to save your plans zip file. In this illustration, I selected my Desktop folder as I will see the plans file on my desktop after it downloads and won't have to search to find the folder where it was saved after downloading. Then, create a folder for your plans and unzip the entire file to that folder, using whatever save folders option your unzip program has to preserve the folder/file structure as in the zip file (three folders for instructions, photos and diagrams). Watch the download box at the bottom of the screen to check the download progress.
